

TRANSFER PROCESSING

A student transferring from another school will be assessed at the current rate per semester or per credit hour for individual courses. A student who has never attended the International College of Broadcasting must pay a registration fee and tuition deposit of \$195.00.

TRANSFER OF CREDITS

The International College of Broadcasting does not guarantee the transferability of credits either to or from other institutions. *Credit transfer is the right of the receiving institution*. An articulation fee of \$100.00 will be charged for each class for which credit is granted. A maximum of 25% of a student's program can be accepted for transfer/test-out credit.

COURSE TEST-OUT

ACCUPLACER course test-out scores are as follows:

English Assessment

College English: WritePlacer score greater than or equal to 7

Math Assessment

❖ College Algebra: Elementary Algebra score greater than or equal to 100

An articulation fee of \$100.00 and a test out of fee of \$100 (total of \$200) will be charged for each class for which credit is granted. A maximum of 25% of a student's program can be accepted for transfer/test-out credit.

CREDIT FOR PREVIOUS TRAINING

Students never having attended the International College of Broadcasting must present a transcript of records to be evaluated and considered for awarding of credit. The grade recorded on said transcript must be a \underline{C} (2.0) or above. Transfer credits are awarded on a one-to-one basis per semester. Credit for course hours not earned within the past five years may be granted at the discretion of the Education Department.

Credit for previous training at the International College of Broadcasting will be awarded for **successfully completed semesters.** Tuition charges will be assessed for the remaining weeks of training left to complete the Diploma or Degree Programs. Payment of a student registration fee is required if the last date of attendance was not within the last twelve (12) months. The tuition will be pro-rated. Diploma Program graduates must complete the current requirements for the completion of the Associate Degree Program.

ARTICULATION AGREEMENTS

The International College of Broadcasting does not have articulation agreements with any other institutions.
