HIGH HONOR SCHOLARSHIP

The *HIGH HONOR SCHOLARSHIP* is available to any student at the International College of Broadcasting that meets the requirements listed below. *The purpose of this scholarship is to promote academic excellence at ICB*. **The requirements are as follows:**

- 1. The student must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.8 or better for the first academic year.
- 2. The student must not miss more than six days for the first academic year.

The scholarship is for use toward the second year of the Associate Degree Program at ICB. *The scholarship is not transferable to any other school or college.* The amount of the scholarship is \$500.00. Recipients of this scholarship will have their accounts credited for \$250.00 the third and fourth semesters.
